## **Trujet connects Bengaluru to Hyderabad**

**Bengaluru, September 10, 2015:** Trujet, a regional carrier focusing on connecting under-served and unserved markets, today announced connecting Bengaluru to Hyderabad with the inaugural flight scheduled to arrive at Kempegowda International Airport at 16:25 hrs and fly out at 16:50 hrs. With this flight, Aurangabad (Shirdi) also gets connected to Bengaluru via Hyderabad.

Addressing a press conference here today, **Mr. Vankayalapati Umesh**, Managing Director, Turbo Megha Airways Pvt. Ltd., said, “Our vision is to connect Tier I cities with Tier II and Tier III cities as we see a great potential in that segment.”

Sharing Trujet’s plans for Karnataka, he said, in the immediate future we plan to connect Bengaluru with Mangaluru, Ballari and Hubballi. Going forward, we plan to connect Bengaluru with Kochi and Aurangabad with direct flights. Across south India, Trujet is eyeing operations to Vijayawada, Vizag, Coimbatore, Madurai, Tuticorin and Salem.

According to Mr. Vankayalapati Umesh, “Apart from providing convenient and affordable connectivity between major business cities, Trujet has a grand design to connect different temple cities and create a niche market segment in temple tourism. As part of this attempt we have already connected Hyderabad with Tirupati & Aurangabad to facilitate pilgrims visiting Tirumala & Shirdi respectively. Likewise, in the immediate future we plan to connect Bengaluru with Tirupati& Aurangabad.” Further, he added, Trujet has prepared a blue print and mapped various temple tourism circuits that could be possibly connected with direct flights.

Currently equipped with two state-of-the-art 72-seater ATR72-500 aircrafts, Trujet will induct one more aircraft in the same class by this month end and will be adding one aircraft each in November and December. By January 2016 Trujet will have in operation a total of 5 aircrafts.
